
The Greek Post Office of Thessaloniki 1912-1950

Thessaloniki is the second most important city of Greece and the capital of Macedonia. It is built in the inlet of Thermaikos gulf, in the North-Western part of the Aegean Sea. In the past, it had an incessant and agitated history. It was established by Kassandros in 315 B.C., in the beginning of the Hellenistic era. Romans, Francs and Ottomans conquered the city from time to time.

During the Turkish domination, Thessaloniki was one of the most important cities of the Ottoman Empire and the biggest harbor of the Aegean Sea. It was the main city of the Balkan Peninsula therefore it was always an important political, military and economic center. So, inevitably, there was a need for an extensive postal facility at least during the last two centuries of the Turkish domination.

On 26 October in the year 1912 the Greek army entered in Thessaloniki and emancipated it from the Turkish domination. The next day, the Greek post office started its function at the city. On August 1914, the World War I broke out. From the middle of 1915 a big multinational army, of 500.000 soldiers, comprised the "Armeé d' Orient". On November 1918 the War finished. Twenty years of peace followed. On September 1939 World War II broke out. On October 1940 Greece was attached by Italians who were warded off. A German attack followed, and on April 1941 Greece was occupied by the German forces. The preoccupancy of Thessaloniki lasted until October 1944. In the end of October of the same year Greek guerillas (EAM - ELAS) entered the city and stayed for a few months. A very hard Civil War follows (1946-1949). From the end of the Civil War and onwards city enjoys a steady period of peace with significant population and economic development.

The Greek Post Office of Thessaloniki 1912-1950 Central Post Office - General Services

The Greek Post and Telegraph Office of Thessaloniki were originally housed within the building of the former Ottoman Post Office on Egnatia Street which was occupied by the Greek policy on the morning of 27^{th} October 1912. The first Greek stamps arrived possibly on the 4^{th} November and after that date the Post Office accepted items addressed to Greece and abroad. By the end of March 1913 the Post Office moved to a newly - built establishment on Alexander the Great street (known today as Katouni Street) near the coast. The new building was completed during the Ottoman Administration. After the Great Fire (Aug. 1917), which destroyed the Commercial Center of the town, the Post Office was transferred to the only saved building, on the Liberty Square. After 1930 the Post Office moved to Tsimiski Street.

The Greek Post Office of Thessaloniki 1912-1950

On 26th October 1912 Thessaloniki was liberated from the Turkish occupation. However for quite a long time after its liberation, we come across postal items incoming from abroad upon which the senders either out of ignorance or consciously, address their letters noting "Thessaloniki Turkey" or "Thessaloniki Bulgaria". The Greek Transportation Ministry had issued an order to the Management et the Thessaloniki Post Office to return such items to their senders. The Management though, did not follow this order, and rightly suggested that the recipients of these "offender" letters should notify their respective senders to use the correct address.

Letter sent from Germany to Thessaloniki with dispatch cancellation HAMBOURG 9.12.13. The sender, a Hambourg commercial firm, addressed the letter to Saloniki Turkei. However Thessaloniki had been liberated from Turkey about a year ago. The addressee deleted the words Saloniki Turkei and returned the letter to the sender adding in the original teat: "Sir, know that there is no longer a city in Turkey but in Greece. From now on please do not write on the envelope Salonique Turquie".







From the beginning at its establishment, the Thessaloniki Post Office accepted the handling of registered mail. The sender had to pay an extra fee, usually being equal to the 1st scale letter Postal Rate.

The Greek Post Office of Thessaloniki 1912-1950 Air Mail

The first airmail connection between Thessaloniki and Alexandria (Egypt) established in 1930 which soon developed to cover other countries as well. In 1931 marked the airmail connection between Thessaloniki – Athens for letter carried by air planes the sender had to pay a special extra fee (depending to distance) which, for many years, was paid by the use of special airmail stamps.

These items could be: registered letters, declared value letters, parcels or even money orders, In such a case the P.O. stamped before the dispatch all the items in question with the special cachet reading "A.R." (= Avis de reception or Acknowledgement of Receipt). The sender paid an extra fee which was the same as the 1st scale letter Postal Rate which was affixed to the special receipt accompanying the item. This receipt was signed by the addressee and subsequently returned to the sender.

French Postal Censorship during W.W. I

On 5th October 1915 the first allied forces (French and British) landed at Thessaloniki. Then gradually built a multinational army which was called "Armeé d' Orient". On 3rd June 1916, Commander in Chief General Sarrail, exhibiting strict rule, set the city into Martial Law. At the same time, the French Military authorities started to impose postal control and censorship of the incoming and outgoing mail which lasted until the end of the war.

Greek Guerillas Postal Censorship - Thessaloniki December 1944 - January 1945

At the end of October 1944 the German troops evacuated Thessaloniki and the guerillas of $E.\Lambda.A.\Sigma$. (Greek Popular Liberation Army - Guerillas Army during the German occupation) took over the city. While in power they censored all incoming and outgoing mail. They left the city at 14 January 1945.

Greek Postal Censorship 1945

In the first year after the liberation of the city from the German Occupation all incoming and outgoing mail was censored by the Thessaloniki Post Office.

Postal Rate: 10 Drs (normal rate 15 Drs) for postal stationery to USA.
