A N N O U N C E M E N T

- 1.** To mark the release of the Commemorative Set of Stamps “The Parthenon Sculptures” on 19 May 2022, Hellenic Post is holding an event to present the set in the Auditorium of the **Acropolis Museum** (Dionysiou Areopagitou 15, 117 42 Athens), on **Friday 20 May 2022, at 7 pm. During the event, it will be used the particular Special Commemorative Postmark.**
- 2.** The Special Commemorative Postmark accompanying the set will also be available on 26 May, 2 June and 9 June at the **Athens Central Post Office, 100 Aiolou St, 10564 Athens, from 9 am to 1 pm.**



- 3.** Stamps to the value of at least **€0.90** must be affixed to each item to be postmarked. Any item to be posted must bear stamp(s) of the appropriate value for domestic or international mail or special delivery service, as the case may be.
- 4.** Alternatively, collectors can send postal items free of charge to the Philatelic Service (100 Aiolou St, second floor, 10188 Athens), provided stamps from the set to the value of at least €0.90 have been affixed to them. Postal items to be stamped with the Commemorative Postmark will be accepted for a period of 60 days from the release of the postmark (the

postmark stamped by the post office from which the item is sent indicates the date of posting). Philatelic items to be postmarked must bear the name and full address of the sender so that they can be sent to them. Please mark the envelope "PHILATELIC ITEMS".

5. At the end of the year, Hellenic Post will release a set of envelopes stamped with commemorative postmarks especially for commemorative postmark collectors. Each envelope will have a €0.90 stamp affixed to it and will be stamped with one of the special commemorative postmarks for 2022.
