SET OF STAMPS COMMEMORATING THE GREEK BOY SCOUT JUBILEE

On the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the Greek Boy Scout Organisation a commemorative set of stamps of symbolic designs will be released.

Thus the services to the Nation by the Greek Boy Scout Corps are illustrated in the stamp showing Scout aid in calamities that befell the Country as well as in another stamp showing Scouts engaged in reafforestation work (40 and 60 lepta values).

The illustration of the Scouts of the three branches contemplating the Greek countryside is symbolic of the Youths' search for a field of activity and good deeds; the picturing of Scouts studying a topographical map suggests their training to prepare before action and the technical education they receive (1 dr. and 70 lepta values).

The 20 lepta value illustrates a Boy Scout overcoming obstacles under the guidance of the Scouts' protector Saint George.

The basis of the universal Scout brotherhood, the Scout Promise, which derives from the oath taken by the Ephebi (Youths) of Ancient Athens, has given the theme for another stamp (30 lepta value).

The 6 drachmae stamp illustrates the Boy Scout flag with all its decorations of distinguished services to the Nation. The same stamp pictures the medal of Military Merit awarded by King Constantine in 1922 (6 drachmae value).

Another stamp will illustrate the bust of H.R.H. The Crown Prince as the Chief Greek Scout (2.50 dr. value).

The special cover honours the founder of the Boy Scout Organisation Lord Baden - Powell of Gilwell and it pictures the first experimental camp he organised in 1907, whence he laid the foundations of the Scout system of educating boys.
