

FLYING MERCURY



**GIOVANNI DA BOLOGNA
(1529-1608)**

The Central motif was taken from the famous bronze statue by Giovanni da Bologna (1529-1608) which is in the national museum, Florence: Italy.

The sculptor, also called Giambologna, was not as one would expect born in Bologna, Italy, but in Douai, northern France.

BACKGROUND

In 1899 the Greek Postal Authorities made a ten year contract with the London paper and printing firm of J.P. Segg & Co., who were in a sense actually the agents of the Greek Government, their proprietor being a Greek National, G. Skliros, for the printing of new postal stationery, a new definitive stamp issue, a definitive A.M. set and a new set of postage due stamps. J.P. Segg & Co. gave the order to Johnston of the Johnstonia Engraving Co. who had invented what he thought was a new method of printing from engraved plates. During 1900, Johnstonia Engraving Co., made the dies not only for the postage stamps but also for the A.M. set and the postage due set.

PRINTING AND TECHNICAL DETAIL

Although the Johnstonia Engraving Co. was charged by J.P. Segg & Co. to print the stamps, they could not do so owing to machine troubles arising from the new method invented by Johnston. So, in March 1901, Johnston handed over his dies, two for each of the lepta values, to Perkins, Bacon and Co., who had been awarded the contract, and they chose the better of the dies to start the printing run. The printing plates of 10 X 10 stamps were made from these dies; the lepta values and the 1 Dr. being engraved and the top three values being lithographed, owing to the metallic colours not lending themselves to engraving.

THE PRINTING PLATES

In the printings of the stamps of this issue, it is generally possible to distinguish two printing periods. In the first period, 1901 to 1905, all values were printed, for the lepta values the plates consisted of 100 stamps made up 10 X 10 and for the drachma values 50 stamps of 5 X 10. During this period only the plates of the 1 and 5 lepta were replaced.

- Rather early, in the 1903 run, it became necessary to produce new printing plates for the 1 and 5 lepta stamps, being the most used values. The second plate of the 1 l. was produced from the same die as the first plate and therefore it is impossible to distinguish between plates 1 and 2 from the stamps only.
- The second plate for the 5 lepta value was made from the same (but retouched) die as was used for the first plate. By means of this retouch the stamps of plates 1 and 2 of the 5 lepta can be identified.
- During the second printing period 1906 - 1910, the values of 1,2,3,5,10,25 and 50 lepta were produced in plates with two blocks of 100 stamps, which would give a gutter. These sheets of 2 X 100 stamps were not delivered as such to the Greek Post Office but were cut into sheets of 100 even before perforating. This is why there exist differences on the printing of plates with the previous printing, for the values 1,2,3,5,20 and 50 l.
- For the 10 lepta plate the original die was retouched and produced stamps that conformed to Types 1 and 2 of the 5 lepta.
- For the 25 lepta the same die was used and no differences have been noted.
- The 30 and 40 lepta values were only printed in 1901 - 1902 and the stock remained sufficient until the end of the life of this issue, and therefore no new plates were produced.
- The engraved 1 Dr., however, was not only printed in the first period but, as stock ran out, was printed again in the second period but from the same die.

THE PAPER

The paper was originally supplied by J.P. Segg & Co. This original thick paper was made by Allen.

The thin paper was supplied by Jas. Wrigley & Co.

All lepta values and the 1 Drachma were printed on both kinds of paper whilst the 2, 3, and 5 drachma values were printed on thick paper.









"SPECIMEN"

Hermes 1 lepta brown to 5 drachma gold, the smaller lepta values in blocks of nine, the larger drachma values in blocks of eight (4X2), all perforated "SPECIMEN" six punctures for each lepta block, four punctures per drachma block, all inverted or reversed, all affixed to four ledger pages and one part page.






COMPLIMENTS CARD



In 1900, after approval of the die proofs, the greek postal authorities ordered from J.P. Segg & Co., a new year card to announce the appearance of the new sets to be made in 1901. This card is a remarkable piece pf professional skill. It is printed on thick cream coloured card, with gilt edges, on which the 5 L., 10 L., 25L., 50 L. values of the flying mercury set of postage stamps, the 3 lepta value of the postage due, the 1 Dr., value of the A.M.Set and the text are all engraved, the golden 5 Dr. of the F.M.Set is lithographed and the greek coat of arms, in gold, silver and blue is embossed.




Some values of the flying Mercury issue that remained in stock at the Post Office, were used later, when there was immediate need for a new issue of stamps but there was not enough time to print them. Hence, we meet stamps of this issue used by the Post Office on 3 Special Occasions between the years 1912-1917, as follows:

- 1) 1912-13: Overprint "ΕΛΛΙΝΙΚΗ ΔΙΟΙΚΗΣΙΣ" on the 20l value
- 2) 1912-13: Overprint "ΛΙΜΝΟΣ" on the 20l value
- 3) 1917: Overprint "Κ.Π." on the values of 1, 3, 20, 30, 40, 50l and 1 Dr.

















A "COMMEMORATIVE" POSTCARD

Looking at the 3 cancellations on this postcard, one cannot come to a logical conclusion. But, when reading the text on the other side, he can approach, quite safely, to a possible one:
The sender of this postcard had been, for some reason, in Athens, during September of 1901. He left for England taking with him some souvenirs and, one of them happened to be, this postcard, cancelled -possibly- at the Post Office just to verify the fact of being there.
Then, some time after, this "souvenir" postcard, was normally sent from England to Italy, where it finally arrived.




